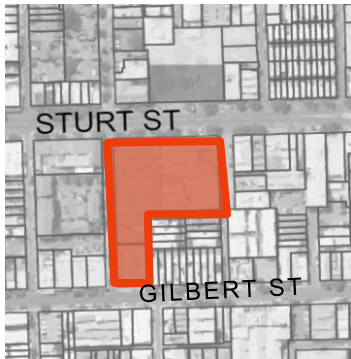

The New Mayfield development was the first approved catalyst site following the 2012 planning reforms and went through ODASA's [design review process](#). The development was approved by the Development Assessment Commission on 14 June 2012\*. The development, designed by Woods Bagot, involves the construction of three buildings of retail and residential apartments, 4 levels of underground parking and an integrated village square with public art installations and water features. The podium levels for each of the towers are finished in either brick, stone or precast concrete. This development is situated opposite the Adelaide City Council Sturt Street Living development ('Ergo Apartments'), which involves a similar development.
